Kids 'n Kinship provides friendships to youth ages 5-16 in need of a positive adult role model.

### **Our Focus**

We match youth in need of support, with screened and trained adult volunteer mentors in the communities of: Apple Valley, Burnsville, Eagan, Farmington, Lakeville and Rosemount. Through their Kids 'n Kinship relationships, youth receive positive attention, experience a variety of activities and develop a sense of self-worth essential to successfully functioning in healthy relationships.

# **2020 Highlights - With the restrictions of COVID protocols, there were many challenges.**

Seasonal activities for in-person events all had to be cancelled and reimagined.

Even during the 2020 pandemic, Kids 'n Kinship was able to form 25 new matches and support a total of 98 matches. Mentors and mentees had to adapt to connecting virtually and came up with many creative ideas. The program supported "Drive-Through" events to share resources

and activities. Four new board members were added.

## 2020 Fund Raising

### **Christian Elder Memorial Ride**

For the 15<sup>th</sup> year, John Elder and his team of cyclists improvised their rides this year by working independently. Despite riding alone, the riders were able to raise over \$39,000 for the program! # Rick's Bike Sale

Due to Covid, the in-person sale could not happen. Appointments had to be made to come and try out the bikes at the Goodyear Superior Service Center in Apple Valley. The sale generated \$33,154 in total for DARTS and Kinship of which Kinship received over \$16,577. The re-furbished bikes ranged in price from \$30 to \$500.

### **Annual Gala**

The 9th Kids 'n Kinship Fundraiser was held in September in the Crystal Lake Golf Club parking lot to celebrate 48 years of serving youth. We asked our donors to "Stick with Mentoring" with an outdoor "State Fair" type event featuring live music, speakers, a traveling drink cart and box lunches delivered to each parking spot. People really enjoyed seeing friends in a safe way. Our event raised over \$45,000 enabling Kinship to continue

providing mentors. Awards were given to the following: Lauren Lupkowski for the Heart of Kinship, Dan Sjolseth for the Friend of Kinship and Boeckermann, Grafston, Mayer CPA's for our Community Partner.
