We match youth in need of support, with screened and trained adult volunteer mentors in the communities of: Apple Valley, Burnsville, Eagan, Farmington, Lakeville, and Rosemount. Through their Kids 'n Kinship relationships, youth receive positive attention, experience a variety of activities, and develop a sense of self-worth essential to successfully functioning in healthy relationships.

2021 Highlights

- 20 new matches and 91 matches were supported!
- Our mentors and general volunteers donated 5,622 hours for a combined value of \$160,451!
- A Pen Pal Program was begun to reduce isolation!
- The program offered Ice Fishing, Bowling, Camp Streefland and Apple Orchard activities.


Kids 'n Kinship benefits from a variety of sources for support for mentoring (see chart):
